

**COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
MOSCOW STATE UNIVERSITY OF PSYCHOLOGY & EDUCATION
(MOSCOW, RUSSIAN FEDERATION)
AND**

The Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Training “**Moscow State University of Psychology & Education**” (MSUPE) represented by its Rector, V.V.Rubtsov acting under the Charter, and _____ represented by its Rector, _____ acting under the Charter, within the frameworks of strategic partnership and internationalization of education, hereinafter called “Parties”, have mutually agreed to conclude the following Cooperation Agreement:

ARTICLE 1

MSUPE and _____ have mutually agreed to develop the cooperation in the following areas:

1. to develop and implement the mutual educational programs on Psychology in accordance with their educational standards;
2. to train qualified specialists (Master and PhD degrees) on the basis of MSUPE and La Sapienza;
3. to conduct mutual researches in Psychology and publish them in special psychological journals of partner universities including researches on the impact of ethnocultural, ethnoconfessional, political and social factors on personality development at ontogenetic levels of development;
4. to build the academic mobility (teachers and scholars, students and postgraduates exchange);
5. to develop direct cooperation (mutual scientific events: seminars, conferences, symposiums, etc.);
6. to organize international schools for young scientists on the basis of partner universities.

ARTICLE 2

In accordance with this Cooperation Agreement the Parties will develop the program of cooperation in the aforementioned areas. Each Party will select its coordinator to control and coordinate the cooperation in each area.

ARTICLE 3

Annually the Parties decide and approve mutually the plan of mutual events and a number of participants of the Parties: teachers, students, master students, postgraduate students and a period of their visits to the partner university.

Visits of teachers and postgraduate students are regulated in accordance with the procedures of the Parties.

Exchange procedures are agreed by additional agreement.

ARTICLE 4

The Cooperation Agreement does not cover financial procedures and regulations between the Parties.

The financial procedures are determined by additional agreements between the Parties.

ARTICLE 5

The Cooperation Agreement becomes effective upon being signed by the Parties and shall remain in effect during the period of 5 years. It can be terminated by either Party at any time by giving the other Party an official three months' notice. By mutual agreement of the Parties the Memorandum can be prolonged.

By mutual agreement of the Parties the Agreement can be amended by the additional Agreement.

ARTICLE 6

This Agreement is made in four copies being equally authentic: two in the Russian language and two in the English language (two copies in each language for each Party).
